Prairie Farm School District Notice of Educational Options

State Statute Section 3224(m) 119.57(1): Annually, by January 31st, each public school shall provide public notice and post on its Internet site a description of available educational options, including: public schools, private choice schools, charter schools, virtual schools, full-time open enrollment, youth options and course options within its boundaries.

Children who reside in the Prairie Farm School District, have the following educational options:

- Attendance at <u>public schools</u>:
 - Prairie Farm Elementary School (PreK-5)
 - o Prairie Farm Middle School (6-8)
 - o Prairie Farm High School (9-12)
- Attendance at <u>private schools</u> and private schools participating in the Wisconsin Private School <u>Choice Program</u>or <u>home-based private education programs</u> as provided under state law
- Attendance at <u>virtual schools</u> Prairie Farm SchooDistrict contracts virtual services through the <u>Wisconsin Virtual School</u> program.
- Full-time open enrollment
- Early College Credit Programand Start College NowProgram
- Parents of children with disabilities are also advised that there is a <u>special needs</u> voucher program.

State Statute Section 3312, s.118.57 states that the School Board's Notice of Education Options must include the most recent school accountability performance category assigned to each school within the district's boundaries, including public, independent charter and private choice schools; and inform parents that the full school district accountability report is available on the district website.
